

RITA- POST OFFICE SIGNED AN AGREEMENT TO TRANSPORT CARGO AND OTHER DOCUMENTS

The Registration Insolvency and Trusteeship Agency (RITA) and the Post Office have signed a memorandum of agreement for the cargo service and Transportation of various documents in all regions of Tanzania Mainland.

Speaking at the briefing of the agreement today in Dar es Salaam the acting Administrator General (ADG) Emmy Hudson said the Post Office has been entrusted with transporting various materials and documents to the District Offices, Directors and Ward offices and thus ensuring security and enabling easy and timely process of registration service.

Ms Hudson added that the Agency transports an average of 10 tonnes of cargo a year which includes a variety of tools and documents such as birth registration forms and deaths that have to be returned to the Headquarters so that they can be safely stored for use by the Government and individuals.

" This agreement will last for one year and will assist in obtaining information on births and deaths as well as divorce and related cargo on time". said Ms. Hudson.

On his part, Tanzania Post Master Mr Hassani Mwang'ombe said the agreement would facilitate the transportation of goods and documents timely to all regions of Tanzania Mainland and assure citizens access to quality services.

Mr Mwang'ombe added that Post Office has modern vehicles and equipment capable of providing logistics and passenger services to various regions of Tanzania Mainland as the Corporation continues to make improvements in information and communication technology systems so that enabling customer s to track their cargo through the mobile phone.

" We have now begun to use ICT in monitoring and archiving to increase the careful handling and transported goods and documents for our customers, "said Mr Mwangombe.

RITA and the Post Office have been collaborating on the provision of services including birth certificates and death certificates verification process for students applying for a higher learning loan where they are provided with an Internet service to send their documents through specialized centers in the Post Offices in all Regions of Tanzania Mainland.
